

REGISTRATION

Due to overwhelming demand the conference has completely sold out. With this in mind, if you are in Berlin for the weekend you are encouraged to come to the venue and register on Sunday between midday and 5pm. Registration on Monday will be open from **8am to 8.55am** so the conference can start at 9am.

FROM SCHÖNEFELD AIRPORT TO THE CITY CENTRE



S-Bahn railway

The S-Bahn (urban railway) runs every 10 minutes and serves the eastern ring line (S9) to Pankow, and the southern ring line (S45) to Südkreuz mainline station where you can change to the S2 to access Potsdamer Platz, Friedrichstrasse and Anhalter Bahnhof. If you travel on the S9 the best place to change is Ostkreuz to access the Alexanderplatz area.



Regional railway (airport express)

The Airport Express (RE7/RB14) runs twice every hour from Schönefeld Airport to Berlin City Centre. The journey time to Berlin Hauptbahnhof (main station) is only 30 minutes. A further regional train service (RB22) provides an hourly connection between Schönefeld Airport and Brandenburg's capital Potsdam.

FROM TEGEL AIRPORT TO THE CITY CENTRE



Tegel Airport is around 12 kilometers to the Kreuzberg area and there will be taxis available at arrivals. However, the bus is a cheaper and easy alternative. Depending on where your hotel is you can choose the:

- **TXL** JetExpressBus to Alexanderplatz;
- **X9** JetExpressBus to Zoologischer Garten;
- **109** Bus also to Zoologischer Garten via Jakob-Kaiser Platz; and
- **128** Bus to Osloer Strasse.
